

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA RELATED TO BROWSING

Identity and Contact Details of the Data Controller

Kastel s.r.l., hereinafter also referred to as "Kastel" or the "Controller," with registered office at via Friuli, 35-37 – 31020 – San Vendemiano (TV), can be contacted via email at info@kastel.it, via PEC at kastelsrl@pec.it, or by phone at +39 0438.401380.

Purposes and Legal Basis

- A. To verify the functionality of the services and thereby enable navigation:** the IT systems and software procedures responsible for the operation of this website acquire, during their normal operation, certain personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of the computers and terminals used by users, URI/URL (Uniform Resource Identifier/Locator) addresses of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the server's response (successful, error, etc.), and other parameters related to the user's operating system and IT environment.
- B. Statistics:** Information is collected to understand how the visitor interacts with the website in order to generate statistics.
- C. Responding to communications received through the published contact details:** When a visitor contacts the Controller using one of the contact methods published on the website, the information voluntarily provided is collected in order to process and fulfil the request.
- D. Defensive purposes:** The Controller may need to process personal data for the management of disputes and legal proceedings, whether extrajudicial or judicial.

Cookies

Some of the purposes listed above may be pursued through the use of temporary markers (cookies). For more information, visitors can consult the dedicated "Cookies" section, accessible from the footer of the website (on the left).

Retention Period

Nature of data provision and consequences of refusal

Purposes	Nature	Consequences
A.	Necessary	Inability to access and use the website.
B.	Optional	Inability for the Controller to perform processing for statistical purposes.
C.	Necessary	Inability to receive the requested information.
D.	Necessary	Inability to manage the dispute.

Scope of Communication

All collected and processed data may be communicated to internal personnel authorized to process data according to their respective duties, as well as to the following categories of external parties, depending on the specific processing purposes:

Purposes	Categories of External Recipients
A.	Parties other than the Controller indicated in the "Cookies" section
B.	Parties other than the Controller indicated in the "Cookies" section
C.	Agents, commercial consultants
D.	Law firms; Judicial authorities

Since the data are also processed using IT tools, they may also be accessible to individuals providing support or maintenance for such systems.

Transfer of data to a third country or an international organization

The Controller transfers personal data to the countries and under the conditions summarized below:

Rights of Data Subjects

The individual to whom the personal data relates is granted the following rights:

Access: You have the right to know if your personal data is being processed and, if so, to access it and request a copy.

Rectification: You can request the updating, correction (if inaccurate), or completion of your personal data.

Erasure: You may obtain the deletion of your personal data under certain conditions (for more information, contact the Controller).

Restriction: You can request that your data be marked to limit its future processing under certain conditions (for more information, contact the Controller).

Objection: You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data for reasons related to your particular situation, where the processing is based on legitimate interest or necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Controller.

Portability: You can receive your personal data provided to the Controller in a structured format and request that it be transmitted to another data controller, if the processing is based on consent or a contract and carried out by automated means.

Withdrawal of Consent: You may withdraw your consent for the purposes for which it was given, without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out up to that point.
